While we are at the field to have fun and enjoy our hobby everyone should be aware of some basic safety information. There is a first aid kit and a fire extinguisher in the shed. Contact a club officer if you need the combination. If you should ever be in need of medical assistance at the field here is how to get help: The closest hospital is Anna Jacques Hospital in Newburyport. Take Rte 95 south to exit 87, go east at the end of the ramp toward Newburyport and follow the hospital signs. If you call for help from the field, call Amesbury Police & Fire Dispatch at 978-388-3765 (you might want to put the number in your cell phone). Advise them to send an ambulance from Amesbury. Directions for the ambulance are: Go out Congress Street; go left on Elmwood Street; stay left at the intersection with Folly Mill Road; the field is on the left, .8 mile from Congress Street. (note: even though Elmwood Street is in Salisbury, the flying field is in Amesbury)

SAFETY

- 1) All AMA Safety rules apply
- 2) When flying you must be behind a safety gate
- 3) Your equipment must be in proper working order and always pre-flight check your aircraft
- 4) No flying over the Pits, the roads or homes.
- 5) Do not taxi INTO pit area
- 6) All UAS aircraft must be in view of the pilot and or spotter including any FPV flying or UAS equipped with GPS.

OPERATIONAL

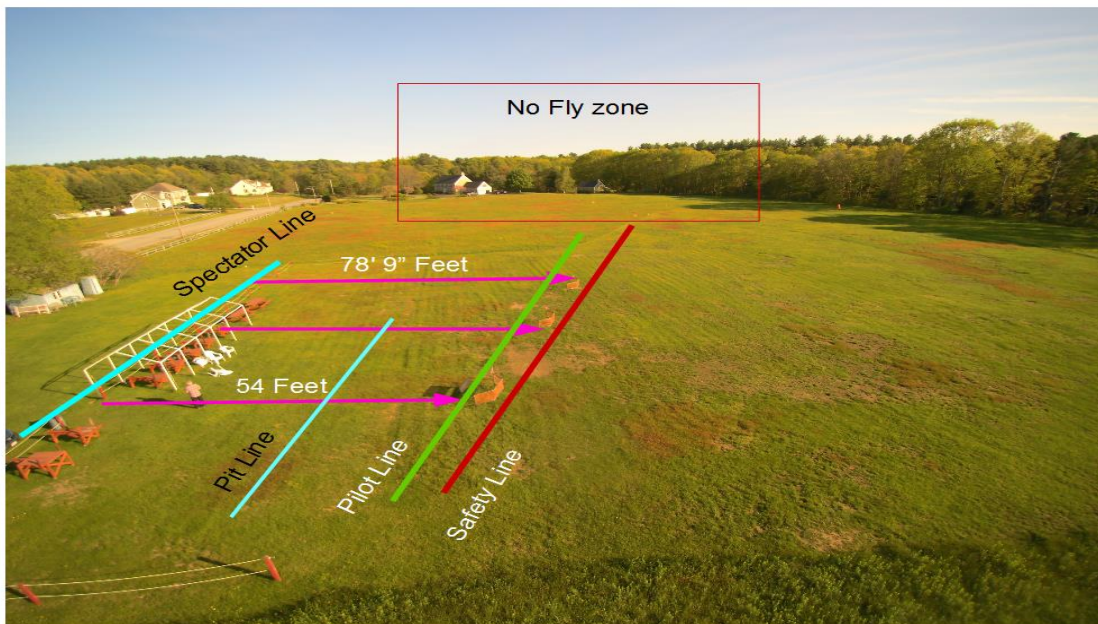
- 1) All rules are to be enforced by all members.
- 2) New Club members shall be required to demonstrate their ability to fly in a safe manner before they fly unsupervised at the Salisbury field. (Article 7 Item 7 added May 10, 1995)
- 3) You must be a current NRCMC member in good standing to fly
- 4) You must have a current AMA membership to fly

- 5) You must have your AMA and membership cards on your person and Your FAA registration number must be on your aircraft. If you bring a guest that person may fly on three occasions, after which they will be asked to join the club.
- 6) No engine start before 9AM
- 7) Sound rule will be 90db at twelve (12) feet.
- 8) Do not fly towards or over the neighbor's property to the left
- 9) Our Field is not in controlled airspace
- 10) Observe Radio frequency controls
- 11) Spectator ropes are meant to be slack
- 12) Trash barrels must be used for small items please carry out your large items.
Voluntary Members take bags For trash disposal.
- 13) Keep the gate locked. Last person to leave the field is responsible for locking the gate.
